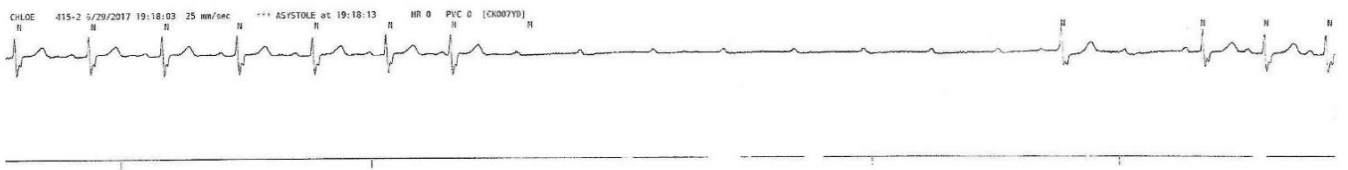

A couple of days later while working in the garden, I had another episode, and again was able to keep from passing out. At that point I called and met with my doctor. She sent me to the cardiologist and put me on a monitor for 24 hours. The next day when I returned to have the monitor removed, as I was walking across to the parking lot, I felt another episode come on. This time I passed out. People quickly got me into a wheelchair and down to the ER. I was then admitted. While in my room, I felt another wave come on and quickly called the nurse. I then asked for a copy of the tape, and she was able to get it for me. After the doctor implanted the pacemaker he said, "Someone was watching over you."
