Questions for Reflection —

- In what ways do you identify with Nicodemus’s not understanding what Jesus’ words mean? What metaphors and images of God are challenging for you? What images and metaphors have helped deepen your understanding of who God is? What will help you grow further in your understanding of God? How do you keep yourself open to further exploration of questions of faith?

- What do you think it means to be born from above? How has your life been reshaped by the Holy Spirit? What does it look like for you to entrust your life to the Holy Spirit's care? What do you need in order to embrace a new life through the Holy Spirit? How can you be more open to what you might never expect or perhaps never even think possible?

- What is the importance to you of community and relationship with other members of the family of Christ? What would it look like for you to invest more deeply in our community of faith? How can we as a congregation be more attentive to our identity as beloved people of God? What might better enable newcomers and guests to experience a sense of belonging?
