Questions for Reflection —

- What is your role in furthering the work that Jesus would be doing if he were physically present here with us? How has Jesus empowered you to go out and do that work? What doubts or anxieties limit your response to Jesus' call? What would it look like for you to rely totally on the power of the Holy Spirit as you undertake those tasks which God sets before you?
- What does evangelism look like for you? How is Jesus sending you to engage the secular world based on your Christian beliefs? What challenges you in speaking about or witnessing to your faith outside the setting of the church or to people who are not believers? What will help you to boldly and faithfully bear witness to God's light and love? How do your lifestyle and your everyday behaviors "preach" the Good News of God's love for all?
- Where/how have you seen or do you see God's image in and the Holy Spirit at work through the people around you? Have you ever discounted someone because of your assumptions about them? What will help you see God's gifts in ordinary people and everyday situations? Have you ever felt overlooked due to the perceptions of others about you? How can we as a congregation better affirm and value each person for who they are and the uniqueness they bring to our community of faith?
