## Vacation Bible School - July 29 - August 2

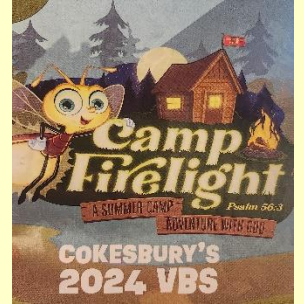
