Turner, a Methodist minister, LAND OF REST is an American folk tune with roots in the ballads of northern England and Scotland; it was known throughout the Appalachians. Gerald Near, one of the finest **composers** of church **music** adapted this hymn tune in his composition, Sarabande.
